The general objectives of the course is to assess the nursing needs to individuals, families and communities throughout life from birth to death; plan appropriate action to meet their needs through competent safe nursing care; to take appropriate action to help people retain or sustain their best possible level of health in all its aspects; work with other members of the health team and community in promotion of health, prevention of illness, restoration of health and rehabilitation.

## **Location**

Vanasthalipuram, the growing area of GHMC, LB Nagar is just 12 km away from Nampally Railway Station and 14 km away Secunderabad railway station, on the national highway of Vijayawada road. It is also very nearer to well-known places like Ramoji film city, Sanghi group of industries, Birla Mandir, Mount Opera, Deer Park and many other Pilgrimage places. Since it is far from the city, the place is very calm and quite and there is no noise and no pollution in this zone. And the area is geographical locations with all natural idyllic settings, wonderful weather conditions. The surroundings will give a feeling of **“home away from home”**.

## **Management**

**ADMISSION TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

**Eligibility Criteria:**

1. Minimum and Maximum age for admission will be 17 and 35 years respectively
2. Minimum education:
  - a. 10+2 class passed or its equivalent preferably with the Science (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) subjects with aggregate of 45% marks
  - b. Those who have cleared 10+2 vocational ANM COURSES (revised after of 2001) from the school recognized by the Indian Nursing Council.
  - c. ANM training i.e., 10+1 ½ years training should have passed +2 or its equivalent examination
3. Admission of students shall be once in a year
4. Students should be medically fit
5. In addition to the above, admission procedure can be laid down by concerned State Nursing Council

(Age relaxation as per Govt. orders for SC/ST/BC from time to time)

**Duration of the Course:-**

The General Nursing and Midwifery course shall be **THREE YEARS AND SIX MONTHS**. There shall be a preliminary period of 12 weeks. The duration of the program has been increased from 3 years to 3 ½ years. The additional six months has been earmarked for internship so that the candidates should be able to develop desired competencies.

**Medium of instruction:**

The teaching of theory and practical will be in **English** only.

**Syllabus:**

The Syllabus is as per Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi, in accordance with A.P Nursing Council prescribed for GNM trainees in all three years and 6 months internship period.

**I year Subjects:** a) Biological Science b) Behavior Science c) Fundamentals of Nursing d) Community Health Nursing and e) English.

**II year Subjects:** a) Medical Surgical Nursing I (including Pharmacology) b) Medical Surgical Nursing II (Specialties) c) Mental Health & Psychiatric Nursing d) Computer Education.

**III year Subjects:** a) Midwifery and Gynecology b) Community Health Nursing II c) Pediatric Nursing.

**Internship Subjects:** a) Educational Methods & Media for teaching in practice of Nursing. b) Introduction to Research c) Professional Trends & Adjustment d) Administration and ward Management e) Health Economics.

**SCHEME OF EXAMINATION:**

At the end of the every academic year the Government of Andhra Pradesh (Board of Examination) will conduct the examinations. 100 marks per each subjects respectively. Out of which the School should send 25 internal assessment marks to the Council/Board. The duration of the examination is 3 hours.

Practical examination is to be conducted in the respective clinical area.

Grading of Examination: a) 80% and above Distinction: b) 70% to 79% First Division c) 60% to 69% Second Division: d) 50% to 59% Pass.

## **HOSTEL:**

All the students are expected to stay in the hostel. Well-furnished spacious rooms are provided for the inmates. Students are not permitted go out without valid reasons. Visitors are allowed during the week ends only at a prescribed timings whose names are written at the time of admission. All the inmates are under the control of Supervisor/Warden. The management has the right to censor the letters of residents as and when necessity arises. Students are not allowed either to cook or to bring food from outside.

Management has the right to refuse permission to unauthorized visitors at anytime.

All the students are expected to bring the following articles:

- a) Steel Plate b) Steel Cup c) Plastic Mug d) Bed Sheets (3 no.) e) Sundries or toilet articles f) Torch Light g) Steel Tumbler h) Steel Spoon I) Mattress h) Plastic Bucket j) Wrist watch Second needle k) Blanket.**

## **Vacation and holidays:**

Annual vacation: 30 days

Sick leave: 10 days

Preparatory leave: 7 days per annum

Sick leave cannot be accumulated from year to year.

## **BOARDING:**

The management as per the INC norms is providing lodging and boarding facilities. The hostel kitchen is very spacious and hygienic to prepare food for the inmates in time. Experienced cooking staff is available to prepare the food to the student nurses. Spacious dining is being provided to cater the needs of hostel mates and 50% of the inmates can be billed on the basis of total expenditure being incurred and divided among students or an amount fixed by the management from time to time.

## **FEE STRUCTURE**

As per GO Ms No 256 of AP Govt, Health, Medical & Family Welfare (K2) dept dated 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2004 the fees structure of the school is:

- i) An Amount of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) per month per candidate can be charged for “Govt Quota Seats”. As regards Management Quota Seats, the fee shall not be more than Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) per month per candidate.
- ii) It shall be competent for the Government to fix the maximum fee chargeable for Government Quota seats and also fix an upper limit in respect of fee for the Management Quota seats.
- iii) The other fees shall be fixed for each candidate per annum for both Government Quota and Management seats as follows

### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS / CONDITIONS:**

1. All trainees have to wear uniform during clinical work and fieldwork.
2. Leave for holidays are provided only on account of genuine reasons.
3. Students who engage in other activities detrimental to the interests of the school shall be dismissed suspended from the school by giving one week – written notice to their parents.
4. All the students must maintain strict discipline, good behavior and respect for the managed staff.

11. Reservation is given to the deserving SC/ST/BC as per the Government rules from time to time.
